  - o Used a designed PSD to create custom homepages and navigations that fits each client's need. All HTML, CSS, and JavaScript were created from scratch.
- Developed a sweepstakes for Gladiator GarageWorks
  - o Using HTML, CSS, PHP and JavaScript the user could upload a photo and place a tattoo on it. Through JSON/AJAX, the photo and tattoo image were sent to an image processing server, where it would compress them into a single photo.
- Created a Wordpress Plugin that shared Inspirations on Aisle3 with other employees
  - This plugin allowed users to submit a link which self generated the title, description, category, tags and image by scraping the links content, which was later added to a list of inspirations displayed on the homepage.

- Developed frontend design and animation for Illinois State University Department sites.
- Created a new template from scratch for future projects with the help from a HTML designer.
  - o Remade the div structure of the site as well as the overall design of the templates. This template was used for department websites.
- Designed logos for Intercollegiate Biomathematics Alliance and Spora

  - Received a \$500 grant from "Friends of the Arts" to create an interactive installation
    - o My team designed and built two large interactive panels with strategically placed LEDs that are controlled using the motion tracking sensors of an Xbox Kinect, Arduino, and a program called Max/MSP.
